As the last President's letter stated, the annual dues have been moved to a due date of March 1st to move them further out from the holiday season.

As I came into office, the amount of delinquent HOA dues was in the thousands of dollars. I am now proud to report that everyone, except one household, has adhered to the payment plan and is making great progress to get these past dues cleared up. Unfortunately, the remaining household will be subject to wage garnishment. The reason it is so very critical for dues to be paid on time is simply we have bills to pay just like you!

One of the recent changes the board has taken action on is the post office cluster boxes. The HOA owns and is responsible for maintaining these mailboxes. In the past, there hasn't been a clear message on how to get issues with locks resolved. Now, if your personal lock is compromised, please reach out to me immediately. If the issue is with a parcel box, you do need to reach out to the Sauk Rapids Postal Office; we do not have access to open the entire box. The board has voted and implemented the following policy. If the lock becomes unusable, there is no fee to you for us to replace the lock. If you lose the keys or are a new homeowner there is a \$20 fee for replacement.

There are several reminders that are the most talked about in regards to the covenants:

• Trailers, fish houses, four wheelers, snow mobiles, campers, recreation vehicles, work trailers, sporting equipment CANNOT be left in yards OR driveways OR streets for more

than <mark>72 hours</mark>. You will get ONE warning per calendar year and then WILL be fined. This is the MOST reported violation

- City ordinance is snow removal on sidewalks is required within 24 hours of last snow fall
- SLOW DOWN, out of the 74 homes 70 have minor children living at home
- Pick up after your pets, the park is not an open pet toilet
- Trash cans cannot be left out beyond Tuesday evening nor can they be stored out openly, put them away
- Vehicles or trailers cannot block the sidewalk

In looking forward, the board is reaching out to the City of Sauk Rapids in hopes of building a pavilion similar that is in the park just to the northwest of us. This is a huge undertaking and will approach city council in the coming months. We will keep everyone up to date via Facebook.

This year we did have a photographer donate his time and equipment to take new photographs and aerial footage of the HOA. This is important to show off our great neighborhood and to increase value.
